Softonic reviewTrello is a web-based project management application, providing tools that help define your tasks and their requirements. This free program works as a kanban app employing a card system that streamlines your productivity. It includes a digital dashboard, where all team members can interact and collaborate with each other on projects.Comparing Trello to other kanban apps, such as Asana and MeisterTask, it comes up short on some features. Nevertheless, it still remains a strong contender due to its straightforward interface and selection of additional features. Figuring out how to maximize its functions may take some trial and error, however.What is Trello used for? Trello is an app used for collaboration. It organizes projects into boards and cards. With this, you can ascertain which task is being worked on, who's working on what, and which work is done. By using the cards, you can organize all projects and day-to-day work to have a clear overview of the progress in your projects. The app can bring your entire team in one platform, making it easier for you to work together seamlessly.As mentioned, it comes with a digital dashboard, where you can create, organize, and prioritize your tasks. It employs a card system, allowing easier collaboration. Even better, it comes with advanced features and power-ups that you can use in organizing your cards. Among these are the color-coded labels. This lets you sort your cards at the level of their priority. However, note that each label requires a color, and you can quickly run out of identifiable color after ten labels or so.Another nifty feature that the app provides is its ability to create automation. Also known as command runs or Butler, this function allows you to follow one action with another. For instance, if someone moves a card to another board, the card's action will automatically check off any remaining subtasks on that card. There is a list of triggers and actions that lets you automate these types of repetitive actions. It's not that exhaustive, but it covers common scenarios.Finally, Trello lets you add more features to your dashboard through third-party Google Chrome extensions. You can add a time-tracker to see how long a task is completed. You can even add a limit to your work-in-progress board, which gives you a warning when you exceed the limit. If you have a paid account that allows integration, you can even connect Trello to other business apps beyond what's in the Chrome Extension store.How do you get started with Trello?Setting up Trello is an uncomplicated matter that only takes minutes. It does not require a mountain of information to get started. You only need your name, email, and password, and you are ready to go. Once launched, it will bring you to your dashboard. From there, you can work on a previously untitled board, or you can create a new one.As noted, Trello's interface is clean and fresh-looking. It is also easy to navigate. Displayed on the main screen are your recently viewed boards and your personal boards. You can create boards from the main dashboard or the Boards tab and name each board to suit the projects. Then, you can further organize your boards by adding To-Do, In-Progress, and Completed tasks. You can even schedule these tasks for certain dates and times.Like any kanban apps, Trello lets you create custom boards. You can make boards with as many columns as you like, and you can name these columns whatever you want. You can also add cards to your task columns, with each card containing lots of details. You can put a name on it and other subtasks. You can also include descriptions and attach files and links to them.Once done, you can then invite people to join your board. All invited users can then move the cards from column to column and even add their own. Note that every movement made on the board is logged in the activity history. With this, you can keep tabs on everyone's progress. Trello boards are blue in the background by default, but you can customize them from the right side of the screen.Is Trello good?Overall, Trello is an excellent task management tool. It is easy to use, flexible, and lightweight enough to suit those who do not need to feature-heavy productivity solution. Setting up is straightforward and only takes a few minutes. Its operation is a bit like using MS Basic itself so if you are familiar with it, you won't be required of any learning curve. The main fighting takes place between these two bases in lanes with defensive towers that must first be destroyed. The game has a variety of cosmetics that can fit any style if you're willing to spend the money on each item.Many championsDota 2 is a sequel to what was once a mode in Warcraft 3 and has improved in many areas since that mod first went live. The game uses many technical mechanics during player combat that can be confusing to new players and is one of the reasons for the serious difficulty of the game. The title's recent update has added new item sets to customize some of your heroes that you enjoy playing. This is done through "the Treasure of Unbound Majesty" which holds a chance to contain one of the new sets and a few rare sets. Unlike with many games from the same genre, you can play any character at any time without having to purchase them first. It's due to this that you could play a million games and not feel as though anyone was a repeat of another. Each team takes turns to pick their champions before the match starts. The massive variety that you can pick from allows you to play a supportive or aggressive style based on your pick. Each hero has its own specified range that will impact how you attack the opposing team. The process for selecting which hero you ban and play is is known as the drafting stage and is always the start of every match. Items One game mechanic that changes everything is the item shop that both teams have access to shopping. The items players purchase will affect their stats and improve their hero's attack damage, movement speed, or a host of other impactful stats. The strategy of knowing what to buy at what time can change the outcome of a fight or the entire match. Of these items, wards are one of the most important as they provide vision to an area without the need for a player or minion to venture there. Another useful item is the boots which speed your character up as they move along the map. The gold used to buy items is earned during the match by killing minions and other players. Additional aid There is a variety of additional software and add-ons for you to use while playing Dota. These tools can give you the edge while playing. One of these is Dota Plus, a tool that helps you during the drafting phase of the game by showing you the best possible bans, picks, and counters to improve your winning chances. By using applications that provide in-depth info during the drafting and battle process, you have a higher chance of destroying the opponent's base. Skills Each hero that you can play has its own set of skills that change your strategy for playing. Heroes such as Oracle provide buffs and debuffs for allies and enemies respectively while healing your teammates if you can successfully initiate a combination with his skills. Other heroes have their own best set of combinations that can deal immense damage to foes and sway the tide of battle once you have your ultimate ability. Professional play There are tournaments held for Dota 2 all around the world, including the Internationals that allow professional players to win a large sum of money. In the past, there have been tournaments in the Netherlands and Sweden. Players As with most online games, the experience you'll receive from your teammates and opponents will change with each match. However, as this is a skill based game, many competitive players can become toxic towards you if you miss actions or get killed too often during the match. The other half of these players do understand that you may be learning a character or are simply new to the game, and may even offer you advice while playing. Guides There are many websites with guides that you can follow for each of the 117 heroes that you can play. These wikis will teach you how to buy items and when to use skills as well as other game mechanics. Alternatives If Dota 2 is not a game you enjoy, you may like other alternative titles that offer just as much competitive multiplayer action.
